

## Key considerations: Academic integrity and generative AI

Building a culture of academic integrity in the age of generative artificial intelligence (gen AI) is a shared responsibility.

The **3 Ps** outline key considerations for every institution to keep in mind.

### Does your institution...

#### Process

- > have an institutional strategy, understood and endorsed by the governing body, addressing gen AI?
- > regularly review and update its policies, procedures and guidance to allow for new and emerging technologies?
- > have staff trained in and dedicated to detecting and investigating academic misconduct cases at scale?

#### People

- > provide training and support to equip staff with the knowledge and skills needed to perform effectively with the increasing prevalence of gen AI?
- > partner with students to inform institutional academic integrity practices and processes?
- > consider the equity, diversity and inclusion implications of any tools students and staff may need, and ensure they are meeting the needs of diverse cohorts?

#### Practice

- > support the redesign of teaching and learning approaches to be fit-for-purpose in a gen AI world?
- > clearly explain what is acceptable and unacceptable use of gen AI, and why?
- > provide support and guidance on maintaining academic integrity throughout a student's entire educational journey?
