Communication

Continuous Improvement

Establish a culture of continuous improvement

- Harness the opportunities presented by TEQSA's current digital and regulatory transformation and projects.
- Establish a Continuous Improvement inbox for staff to raise pain points, frustrations, and practical ideas for improvement.
- Track all improvement ideas through a central register.

Learning and Development

Ensure our staff are supported and have the training, tools and resources they need to be successful

- Refresh our Learning and Development Framework.
- Refresh mandatory online learning to ensure fit-for-purpose modules that support staff development.
- Improve staff awareness of learning and development opportunities on offer and how to access them.

Culture
